Bautzen is the midpoint of the Upper Lusatia and renowned for its historical town centre with its skyline of mediaeval towers. The uniqueness of the city lies in the variety of its attractions - the well-preserved and painstakingly restored historical old-town and interesting German and Sorbian cultures. A tour of the old city with visits to churches, museums or galleries is always a rewarding experience.

The next guided walking tour will take you around the Old Town of Dresden. Step by step you learn more about the capital of Saxony, its former rulers – the house of Wettin and their collections e.g. in the Residential Palace. You get a closer look at the Semper Opera House and the famous Zwinger Palace. One of the highlights is the rebuilt "Church of our Lady" and the surrounding architecture.

Gold, rock crystal and diamonds seem to want to outshine each other in the treasury of August the Strong, which he built between 1723 and 1730. The Historic Green Vault allows visitors to immerse themselves in the authentically restored rooms of the treasury.

The excursion will be in English.

Each participant will receive a packed lunch during the bus ride.
