Be impressed by the architectural diversity of this historic city, which is among the best preserved in the whole of central Europe. Görlitz is regarded as the largest single site of architectural significance in Germany. Its 4,000 land-marked buildings, most of which have been lovingly restored, are witness to the great riches of the past. The inns of bygone days are today inspiring locations where guests can experience a unique feeling of well-being.

Imagine the past of the once so important European trading metropolis in an exclusive hall building exhibition at the “Brüderstraße”.

Exchange your secrets at the Whisper Arch (Flüsterbogen), the famous late gothic portal.

Gain an impression into the Old and New Testament through the sandstone relief at one of the city's most famous Renaissance buildings.

Visit the church „St. Peter and Paul” which is a five-aisled late-gothic hall church built between 1425 and 1497. It is the biggest of its kind all over Saxony and shapes the cityscape like no other. The baroque “Sun Organ” built by Eugenio Casparini, at that time a very famous organ builder living in Italy, is of particular importance. It dates back to 1703 and was reconstructed by Mathis Orgelbau AG between 1997 and 2006.

Stand on the Old Town Bridge (Altstadtbrücke) which connects two cities (Görlitz and Zgorzelec) of one Euro city.
