Experience one of the best-preserved department stores of the early 20th century known to many people through the award-winning movie “The Grand Budapest Hotel”.

Afterwards the tour takes you to the Upper Lusatia Library of Sciences (Oberlausitzische Bibliothek der Wissenschaften). With 140,000 librams it is the largest library in the city of Görlitz. It promotes the transfer of knowledge and identity between Germany, Poland and the Czech Republic and preserves and lends literature about the Upper Lusatian region.

Finally dive into the “Nikolaivorstadt” of Görlitz and learn about richly decorated graves and baroque tombs on the graveyard “Nikolaifriedhof” and visit the site of the Holy Sepulcher. It is an impressive testimony of late medieval piety and landscape architecture of European rank. The entire complex is a replica of the main parts of the great sepulcher church in Jerusalem, a place of remembrance of the suffering, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
